FACE COVERINGS

- Face coverings are optional outdoors in all school settings.
- CDPH requires all students and adults to wear a face covering while indoors at school and on school transportation unless exempted per CDPH guidance, regardless of vaccination status.



DISTANCING

- CDPH removed minimum distancing requirements for the 2021-22 school year.
- Lunches will maximize distancing as much as possible (especially when indoors). Students will eat outdoors if possible.

WELLNESS CHECKS

- Families are asked to perform daily wellness checks on their student prior to coming to school, including taking temperatures. If a family needs a thermometer, they will be made available.
- Students and staff should stay home if they are not feeling well, including if they are demonstrating any symptoms related to COVID-19.



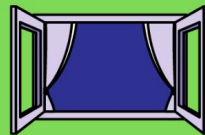
HYGIENE PROMOTION

- Staff will teach and reinforce students washing/disinfecting hands.
- Hand washing/disinfecting will be promoted before and after using shared equipment/materials.



CLEANING & VENTILATION

- Daily cleaning of high touch areas will occur in schools and buses.
- If potential exposure to symptomatic individuals, increased cleaning will occur in specific areas.
- Staff will maximize airflow inside buildings and incorporate outside learning opportunities.



QUARANTINES

- Vaccinated close contacts that are asymptomatic do not need to quarantine or be tested.
- Unvaccinated close contacts when both parties were wearing masks, may continue to attend school in person as long as they are asymptomatic & guardians self attest via district provide online form, to have exposed students tested to COVID-19 two times per week during the 10 day quarantine period.

Excellent education. Every classroom. For every student. Every day.

SCENARIO 1

Child is exhibiting one or more of the COVID-19 symptoms

frequent cough
fever over 100 degrees
sore throat
difficulty breathing
headache
recent loss of taste or smell
chills
nausea
vomiting
diarrhea
muscle or body aches
runny nose or congestion
fatigue

Complete a daily wellness check for your child, including taking their temperature.*

Child is demonstrating symptoms at home.

Keep the child at home and inform the school of absence.

Child is demonstrating symptoms at school.

Child is referred to health office.

Parent/Guardian may be contacted if child needs to leave campus. Must be picked up within 15 minutes.

All of the following conditions must be met for your child to return to school:

CRITERIA 1

Fever-free without the use of fever-reducing medications for at least 24 hours.

CRITERIA 2

Other symptoms have improved.

CRITERIA 3 (Choose one)

- Documentation from medical provider.
- Negative test verified by staff.
- 10 days symptom-free

3 OPTIONS

VACCINATED

1

Child attends school as long as symptom-free.

2

Modified 10 Day Quarantine*
Child may attend school if:

1. No symptoms
2. Wear mask
3. Negative tests 2x/week for 10 days

No extra-curricular activities.

UNVACCINATED

Child OR Positive were not masked

3

Quarantine At Home
Child can come back to school:

No Test
After day 10

Negative Test**
After day 7

***if tested after 5 days of exposure*

SCENARIO 2

Child has been in close contact* with someone who tests positive for COVID-19.

***more than 15 minutes over a 24-hour period with 0-6 feet INDOORS*

SCENARIO 3
Child tests **positive** for COVID-19

SCENARIO 4
Child tests **negative** for COVID-19



Scenarios based on CDPH (California Department of Public Health) requirements

Child takes COVID-19 Test

Child tests positive for COVID-19.

Keep the child at home and isolated. 10 days from symptom onset of if no symptoms, test date.

Child tests negative for COVID-19.

SCENARIO 1

Symptomatic, but not close contact:

Child may return to school when:
No fever for 24 hours AND other symptoms improved*

SCENARIO 2

Close contact, unvaccinated, no mask:

Child may return to school after day 7 of exposure if:
No symptoms AND Negative test is after day 5 of exposure
