KEEPING OUR CLASSROOMS

PREVENTION

Students should...

- stay home when sick.
- wash hands. Students will be taught hand hygiene and provided time throughout the day to wash or sanitize hands
- stay up-to-date with required immunizations.
- wear a face covering when students are symptomatic, have been exposed, and during isolation period. (recommended but not required)
- test for COVID-19 if they have symptoms or have been exposed. (recommended but not required)

Staff will optimize indoor air quality

COMMUNICATION

If a student tests positive...

- parents should contact the school office or email schoolnurses@eurekausd.org as soon as possible.
- the school nurse will work with the family to confirm a safe return-to-school date.



If a student is exposed in school...

• parents will receive notification via email or hard copy.

MITIGATION

EXPOSED

If NO symptoms, students may come to school and participate in all activities.

It is recommended (not required) to test 3 to 5 days after exposure and wear a mask for 10 days.

SYMPTOMATIC

Students should stay home until fever-free for 24 hours without medication and symptoms improve.

It is recommended (not required) that students take a COVID-19 test (at-home tests are available in school offices) and wear a mask for 10 days.

POSITIVE

Students should isolate and not attend school for 5 days after symptom onset or positive test.

Students may return to school on day 6 if symptoms have improved, they are fever free without fever reducing medication, and has not vomited or had diarrhea for the past 24 hours.

It is recommended (not required) to wear a mask through day 10.
